Chief's Report

- OVFR is conducting weekly meetings to evaluate COVID-19, and determine best practices to continue to keep staff healthy and able to respond to our community.
 Our new hires are currently utilizing on-line classrooms for their EMT training and may be tested daily upon returning to in person learning at CPFR.
- Chief Gibson gave an update about the master plan and has seen the preliminary first document. More to follow upon completion of documents.
- Chief Gibson spoke about the recent flooding events which have been relatively insignificant in the big picture, but there has been more standing water in town locally.
- The FBC notification letters have gone out in the mail. Staff has handled inquires as they have come in. Most citizens needed clarification, only a few appeals have been requested thus far.
- Chief Gibson will be having shoulder surgery in the next few months, will be out of the office on a limited basis.
- OVFR was awarded a grant from the Pierce Conservation District for the Patterson Road Fire Risk Reduction project in the amount of \$5,000.
