Chief's Report

- Chief Gibson gave an update on the number of cardiac arrest survivors since OVFR began the Cardiac Arrest Initiative in 2019. Currently we are at a 25.8% survival rate, up from 9% prior to the initiative and our updated equipment.
- Chief Gibson presented the FBC results by precinct and gave an update of costs to several types
 of facilities.
- Chief Gibson presented the current position of the 2021 Budget and the preliminary 2022 Budget in relation to the direction the District is headed with the passing of the FBC.
 - MSO Helmers followed up with the current state of hiring paramedics and/or sending candidates to paramedic school. OVFR will continue to capitalize on students that are currently in school, soon to be graduating.
